Introduction:

Crosstown Civic Credit Union is committed to being a sound, progressive, and growing financial institution by providing our members with superior financial services and products while maintaining our traditional values.

Purpose:

Crosstown Civic Credit Union's Scholarship is designed to reward all-around excellence. This scholarship will be awarded on the basis of exceptional academic standing and noteworthy participation in extracurricular activities in and outside of school.

Support:

Crosstown Civic Credit Union will award four \$500 scholarships annually.

Eligibility Criteria:

- Applicants must be **members of/ immediate family of members of Crosstown Civic Credit Union**. (As of September 1 of the current school year).
- Applicants must be currently attending high school and graduating in **June of the current year**.
- Applicants will be attending an approved post secondary institution in **fall of the current year**.
- Children/grandchildren of current board and staff are not eligible.

Application:

- All applicants will be considered for the scholarship.
- To apply, applicants are required to complete all sections of the application form. No other form, size or type will be considered.
